In our Sunday morning classes upstairs, we just got through going over the book of Judges. Yes, I know it's violent and yes, it is sad. However, I think that it is a book that we can all learn from when it comes to improving our faith.

So Judges takes place right after Joshua dies, and the Israelites have roamed the land of Canaan, along with the foreign nations. You may notice as you read that Israel decided to not drive out these nations, but yet God called them to roam and make the land for themselves. We ultimately see this continued cycle of Israel following God, disobeying, whole nation gets in trouble, the Lord sends someone, they follow again.

When I talk about this cycle, we like to think that with all of the great things that happened in the Old

Testament that we would never do that. But that isn't the case. Paul talks about our consciousness and who we follow in Romans 7:14-20.
