My dad was many things, and I have many great memories I made with him. Some of my favorite memories of my dad were working with him. He was an extremely hard-working person, and I remember the phone ringing at 2 or 3 in the morning and heading out into subzero temperatures to rod a sewer line or fix a water leak. I learned from him that part of being a man and a father was being a good worker and being dependable.

I don't know much about Joseph, but I know he was a carpenter. The truth is, I don't know a lot about first century carpenters, but I can imagine it was backbreaking work, doing everything by hand. I know stone masons were revered in that society, and I imagine that being a carpenter was also an honored profession. It was also a profession that could be practiced anywhere. Have we ever thought that maybe God didn't just

pick Mary, He picked Joseph?

The angel appeared to Joseph and said, "do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife." We don't often consider how Joseph felt, but in that society, he was setting himself up for a huge disgrace. Maybe that is why they stayed in Bethlehem instead of going back to Nazareth. Thankfully, he had a skillset that allowed him to work there, and later in Egypt. When he returned to Nazareth, he was able to go to work and support his family. He, apparently, built up quite a reputation, when Jesus returned, they knew him as Joseph the carpenter's son.

It appears that Joseph did not get to see what his son grew up to be. I believe that, maybe, part of the man Jesus was in the flesh reflected part of his earthly dad. His integrity, his honesty, and his dependability. I know we see God in Jesus, but maybe we see a little of Joseph too.
