Maybe that is why they stayed in Bethlehem instead of going back to Nazareth. Thankfully, he had a skillset that allowed him to work there, and later in Egypt. When he returned to Nazareth, he was able to go to work and support his family. He, apparently, built up quite a reputation, when Jesus returned, they knew him as Joseph the carpenter's son.
