Hope

What makes us give up, on a relationship, or a job, or anything else in life that we are involved in? We can blame it on many things, dissatisfaction, maybe a better offer, but what is the root cause? Most of the time, it is the loss of hope. We don't see things getting any better, we often perceive that we are in a closed loop, and we think the only way out is to get out. On a deeper level, when we lose hope in ourselves, and we seek to escape, it can lead to addiction, or even death.

Statements such as, "I am tired of trying" or "I can't stand it anymore" exemplify the idea that the end is near. To get past this phase in a relationship, we need the hope of change. What we must consider is that sometimes we have to be the change agent, instead of waiting for someone else to change. I think this is where faith and teaching of Jesus really step into the equation.

Romans 12:2 ² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

The one thing I can control in my environment is me. God understands this, that through Him, I can be transformed, I can be different. The hope I have in me of eternity, of a God who cares for me, can change my world.
