## “What Did I Give?”

The widow walked toward the pot where the offering was placed. Those around her were oblivious to the woman, surrounded as they were by the glory of the temple and those dressed in fine robes with broad fringes. “Maybe no one will notice me,” she thought, “they never have before. It does not matter—I do not matter—look at my copper against the gold in the kettle. They throw their coins in to make a noise, so people will know how much they give, I place mine in so no one will know how little I give. I will just put my two mites in quietly and quickly so no one will notice.” She, however, did not see the one watching her, her eyes were downcast, but His eyes, however, never left her as she made her way to the kettle. She placed the mites in quietly, but He knew their worth, and knew her worth. You see, the scripture states she gave all she had to live on—Jesus knew her heart, and it was wonderful!

The question was asked if we do not tithe, how much should we donate? The answer to that question is uniquely

personal. You and God are the only ones who know your heart, however, there are some helpful hints.

*2 Corinthians 9:6-7: Now this I say, he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. Each one must do just as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.*

Giving should be a purposeful event. We should pray about it and discuss it with our spouse, if that is relevant. We should be cheerful in our giving. But mostly, it should be a sacrifice, not just our excess or our leftovers.

Remember, there are many things we give to God, not just money, but time and energy. All our giving, whatever we are giving, should follow the same pattern. Purposeful, cheerful, and sacrificial.
