“Prayer Life”

A couple of months ago, around Christmas time, I was feeling really bad about myself. The weather was cold, dark, and grey skies were all around me, so I couldn't physically see a lot of positive things around me. I was exhausted from the events we were doing, I was worrying about unnecessary stresses, and it seemed like a lot of friends and family just kind of moved on from me. So I decided to reach out to one of my friends and give him a call, and he asked me a question that has actually been coming up in my life more recently. That question was, “how's your prayer life been lately?” And I realized that my prayer life has been terrible for me. I usually was falling asleep every night saying a prayer, and that was all. Now is it wrong to think about God when I go to bed, no, but that was the only time I was even trying to talk to Him.

Throughout my life and scripture, I have seen that the most faithful people are the ones that incorporate a daily prayer life and truly communicate with God. And so as Christians, we can understand that God doesn't just appear magically like a genie when we get down

on our knees and say some magic words, He is always there to communicate to us. We can see with the story of Daniel in the lions den (Daniel 6), Daniel prayed to God 3 times a day, meaning that he made sure to commit his life to communicate with God.

Throughout the Psalms, David would pray and write his thoughts and feelings he was going through, and God was available! And finally, with Jesus in Matthew 26, when Jesus prayed in the Garden, He could have refused to go through with his death, but He knew that having that connection with God was able to help him through the beating, spitting on, and other sufferings that He bore.

This thought had just occurred again, and it has really got me thinking about how much I lack in my prayer life. So when we are communicating with God, He wants to listen to you and knows what is best for you! A challenge I had for the youth group was to write 5 things that you could pray for the next week, and I challenge you too. This is a good way that we can jumpstart the habit of communication with God, so that we can act on our faith, not on our feelings.
